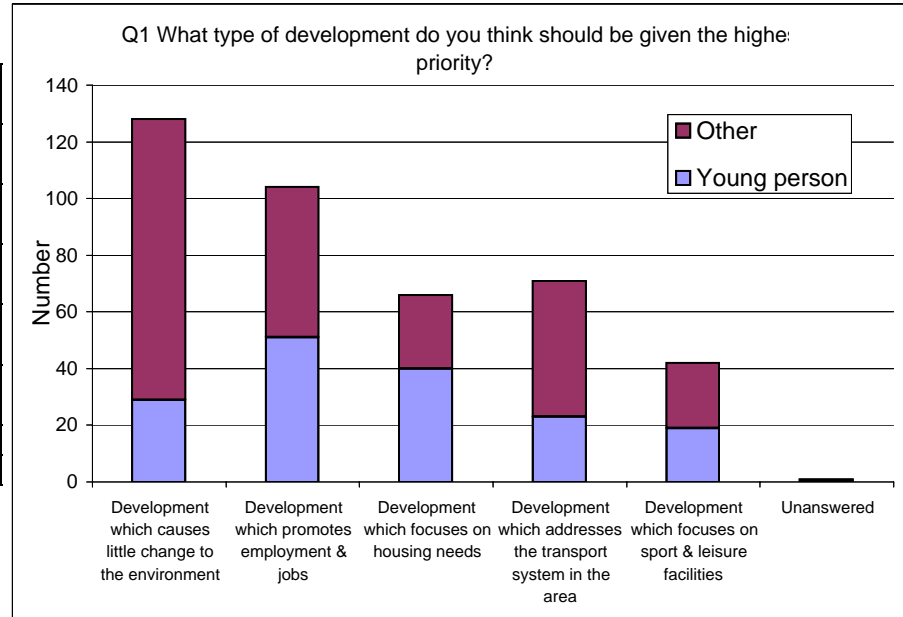

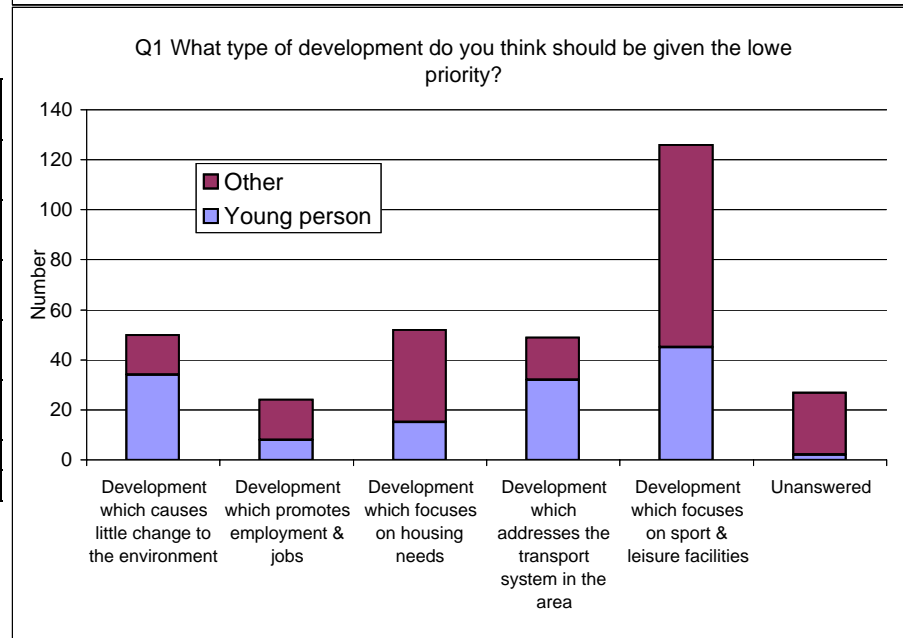

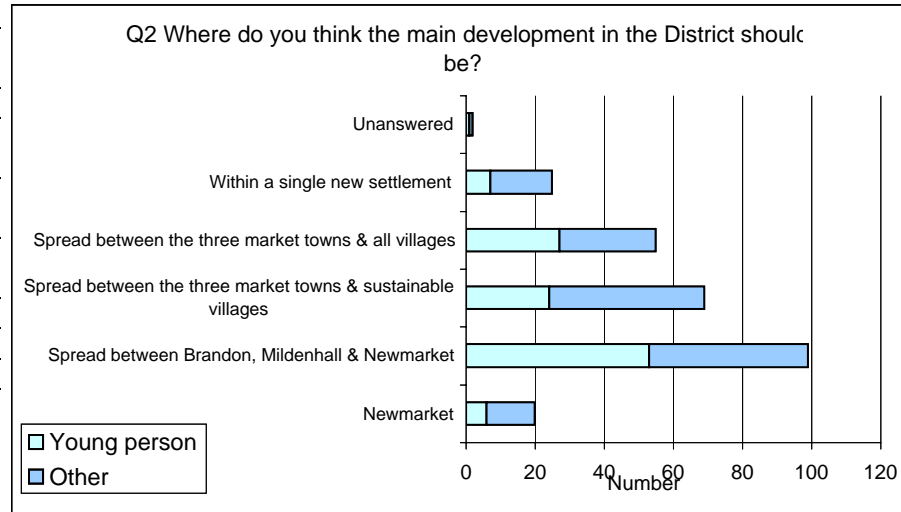

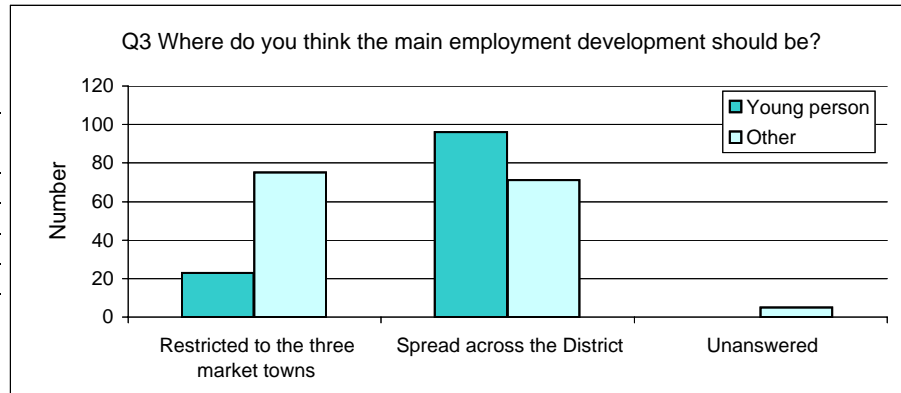

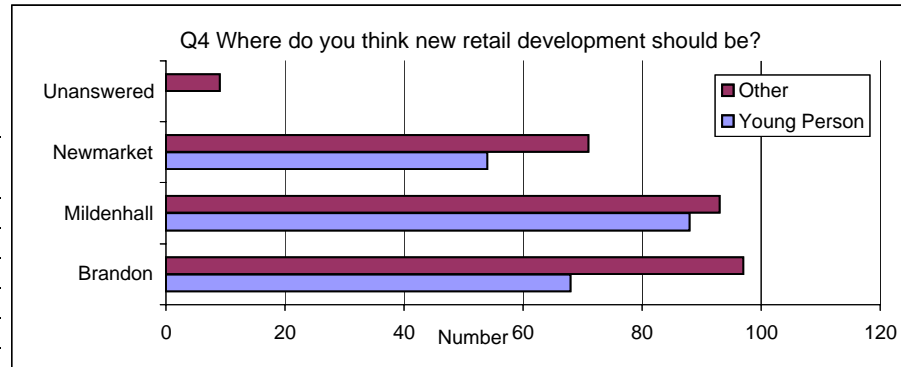

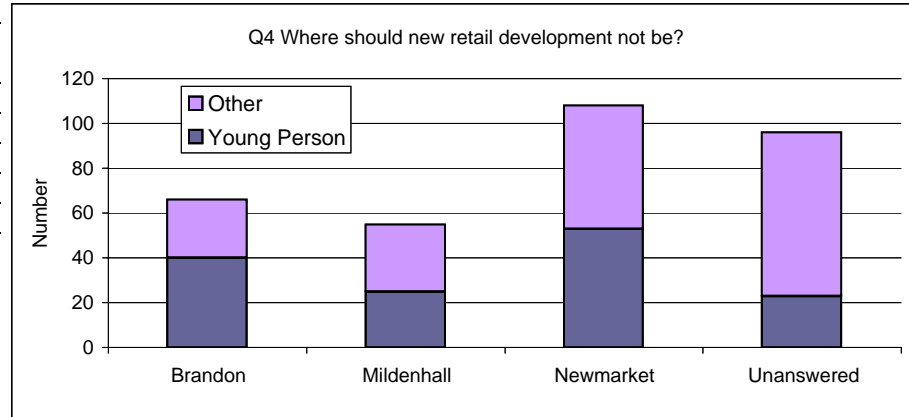

Q4 Where should new retail development not be?

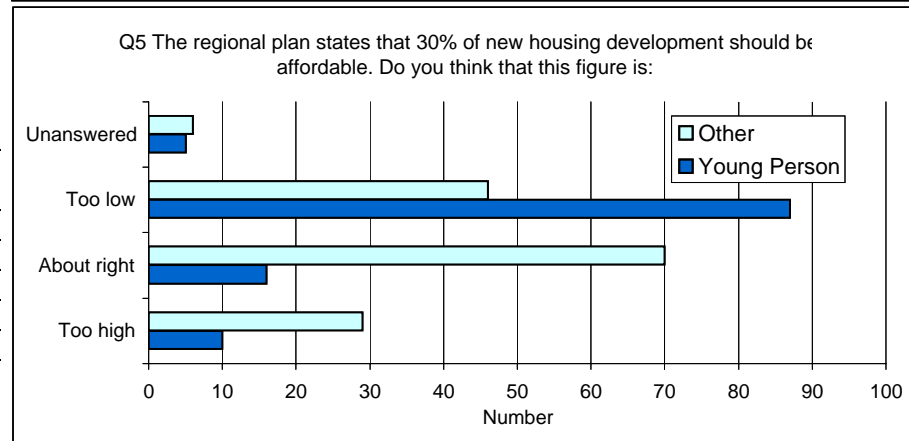
